Every finding benchmarked. Every recommendation *usable*.

The findings belong to DanChurchAid. What we can share is the method — a standards-based, utilisation-focused assessment designed to leave working instruments behind, not just a report.



Standards-based.

Practice assessed against the Minimum Standards for Child Protection in Humanitarian Action, the Inter-Agency Minimum Standards for GBV in Emergencies, and the IASC MHPSS Guidelines — alongside inter-agency case management and protection mainstreaming guidance.



Four lenses.

Services, documentation, reporting and donor engagement — strengths and priorities stated explicitly across each.



Triangulated evidence.

Every finding anchored to an explicit benchmark and cross-checked across at least two evidence streams.



Instruments, not just analysis.

A 2026–2028 protection strategy with a 19-indicator measurement framework, a Protection Information Management Tool with its governing SOP, and contextualised SOPs for case management, psychosocial support and safe-space management.
